- Rapid heartbeat, indications of infection, muscle cramps, yellowing eyes/skin, dark urine,

trouble urinating, indications of kidney problems should all be reported to your doctor.

- This drug has the potential to elevate your blood pressure. Regularly monitor your blood pressure and notify your doctor if the readings are too high.
- Blood clots are a rare side effect of bevacizumab (such as pulmonary embolism, stroke, heart attack, deep vein thrombosis). If you have a background of blood clots, heart/blood vessel illness, or are sedentary, you may be at higher risk for blood clots.
- Bevacizumab injection can create a condition called PRES in some people (posterior reversible encephalopathy syndrome). If you get a chronic headache, seizures, severe vision abnormalities, or mental/mood disorders, seek medical care immediately.
- This medicine seldom causes a severe allergic reaction. However, if you observe any indications of significant allergic response, seek medical attention right once.

- When combined with other drugs, bevacizumab Injection is a successful first-line treatment for some cancer diseases such as colorectal, lung, cervical, and kidney tumours.
