What is Gemcitabine injection?

Gemcitabine injection is used in the treatment of ovarian cancer (cancer that starts in the female reproductive organs where eggs are generated) that has returned at least 6 months after a previous therapy. It's also used in conjunction with

[paclitaxel](#)

to treat the breast cancer that hasn't responded to other treatments or has worsened.

Gemcitabine and cisplatin are used to treat a kind of lung cancer that has spread to other places of the body and is resistant to surgery. Gemcitabine can also be used to treat pancreatic cancer that has progressed to other places of the body and has not improved or worsened following prior treatments. It belongs to Antimetabolites type of medication.

Gemcitabine Injection - How To Use

- Gemcitabine is available as a powder that must be combined with fluids and given intravenous by a doctor at a medical institution over a 30-minute period.

- It is frequently given on specific days every three weeks to treat ovarian or breast cancer.
- When treating lung cancer, gemcitabine is commonly given on specific days every 3 or 4 weeks.
- It is a drug that is injected once a week to treat pancreatic cancer. Treatment duration is determined by the drugs you're receiving, how well your body reacts to them, and the kind of cancer or illness you have.

Precautions for Gemcitabine

Before Receiving Gemcitabine Injection,

- If you have an allergy to gemcitabine, any other drugs, or any of the substances in gemcitabine injection, notify your doctor.
- Tell your doctor about any additional drugs, vitamins, nutritional supplements, or herbal products you're taking or planning to use.
- If you drink or have ever drunk a lot of alcohol, or if you have or have ever had liver illness, including hepatitis, or renal disease, notify your doctor.
- If you are pregnant, expect to become pregnant, or plan to father a child, notify your doctor. Consult your doctor about taking birth control during your gemcitabine medication to avoid pregnancy.
- If you're breastfeeding, let your doctor know. You should not feed for 1 week following your final dose of gemcitabine injection and while you are receiving the injection.
- You should be aware that this medicine may reduce male fertility. Consult your doctor about the hazards of gemcitabine treatment.

Benefits of Gemcitabine Injection

In Non-small cell lung cancer,

- Non-small cell lung cancer is one of the most common types of lung cancer, affecting smokers and non-smokers alike. Gemcitabine Injection can be used alone or in conjunction with other medications to treat non-small cell lung cancer. It's a powerful and poisonous medicine, so talk to your doctor about the dangers and advantages. While

undergoing this treatment, you should avoid consuming alcohol and drink enough of water to stay hydrated.

Gemcitabine Injection - Side Effects

- The most of side effects are minor and will go away as your body responds to the medication. If they don't go away or you're concerned, see your doctor.
- It's possible that you'll experience nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea, mouth sores, tiredness, muscle pains, and pain/redness at the injection site. It's possible that you'll experience temporary hair loss. After the procedure, normal hair growth should resume.
- Serious side effects, such as, cough, dizziness, rapid heart rate, kidney or liver problems should be reported to your doctor.
- If you experience unusual weariness, pale skin, symptoms of illness or easy bruising/bleeding, contact your doctor straight away.
- Contact your doctor if you experience any other side effects not listed above.

Some Tips for Gemcitabine Injection

- Prevent pregnancy while taking this medication by using a reliable contraceptive technique.
- If you see any signs of infection, such as a fever, sore throat, rash, or severe diarrhoea, call your doctor right away.
